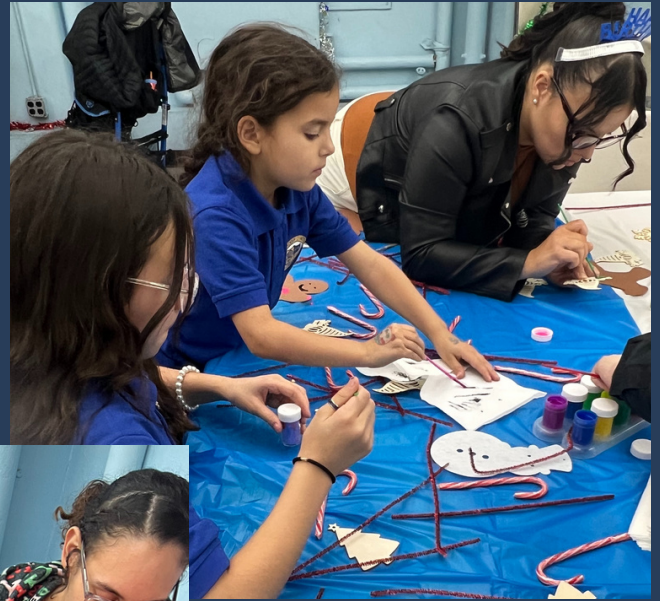

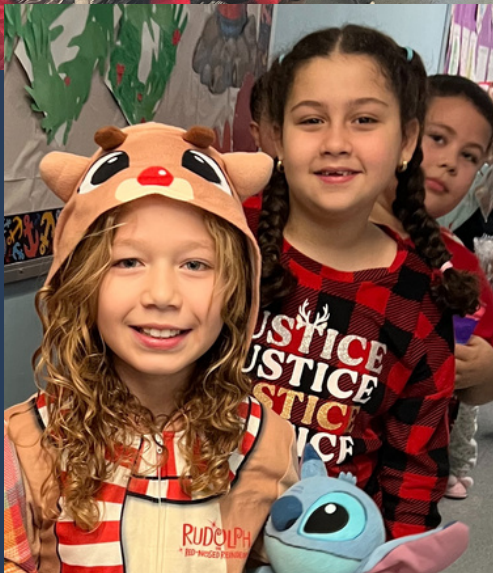

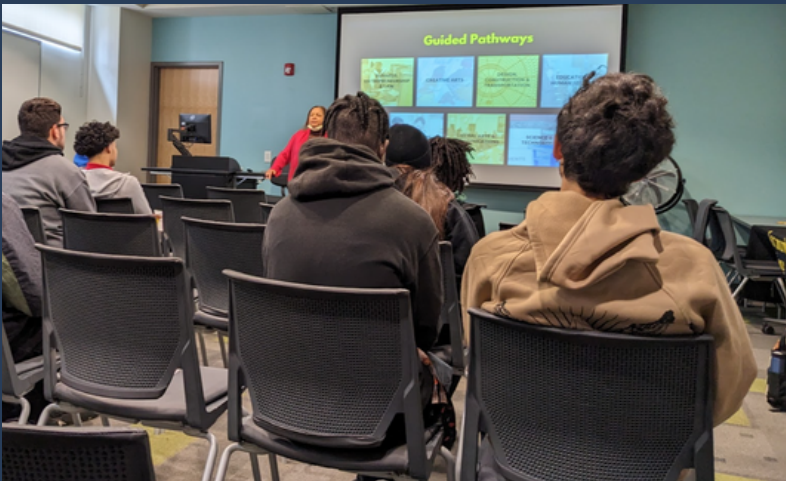
More from the Center City Tour

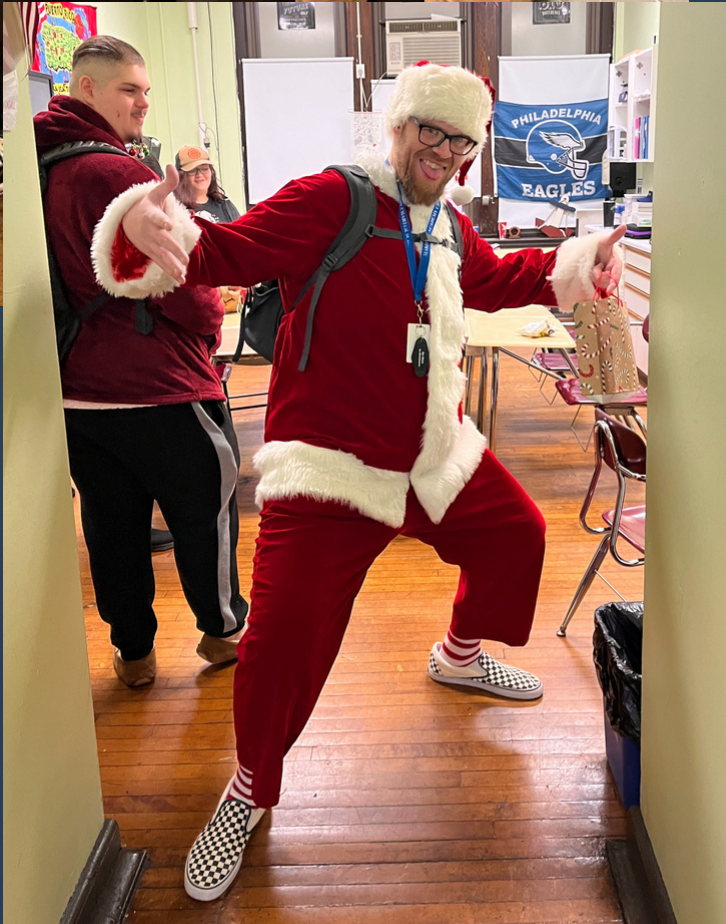
