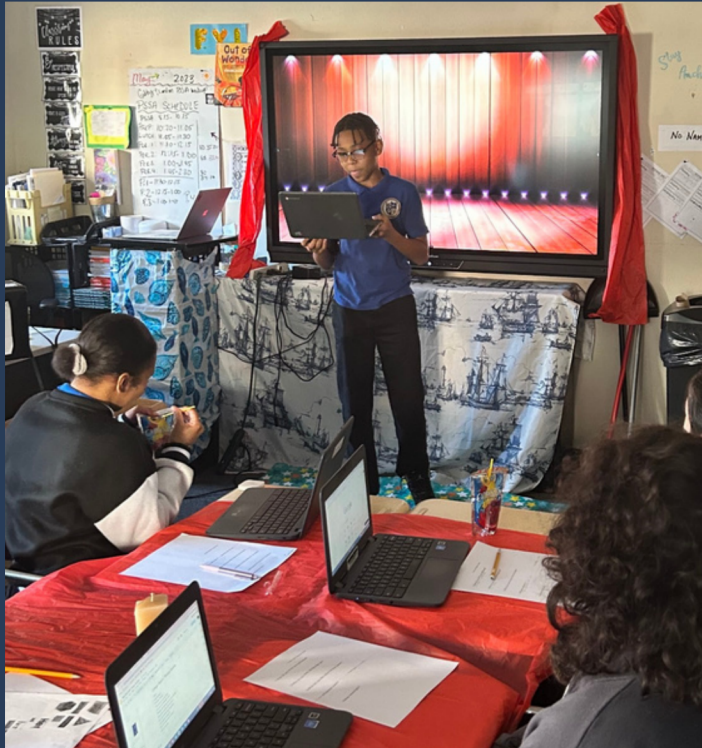
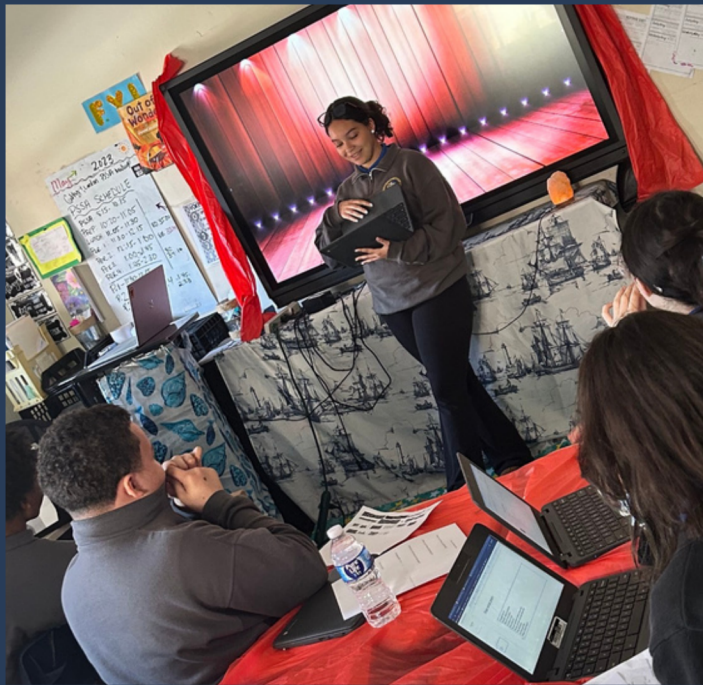

8TH GRADE POETRY CAFE



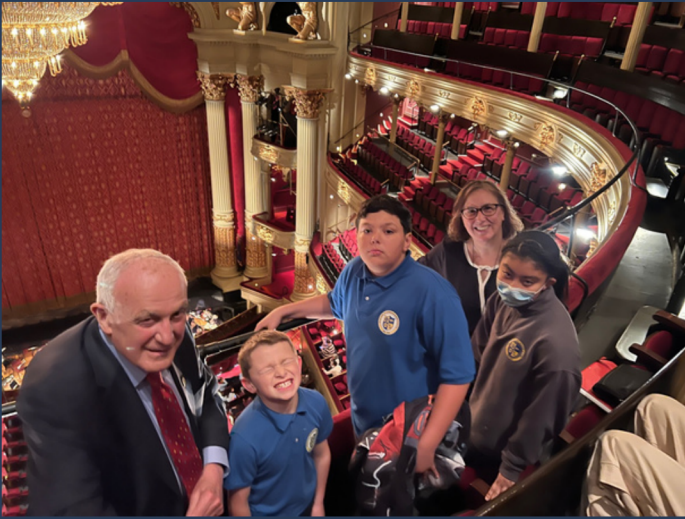
Ms. Laverghetta's 8th grade held a "Poetry cafe day" to end their poetry unit. Students read their own poems!

First, cadets shopped for items to include in the kits by using the list provided to us by The Ronald McDonald House:

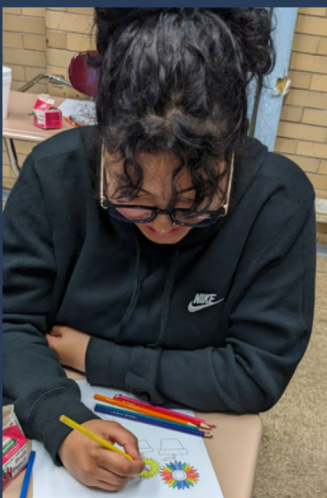


Next, cadets worked to put together kits for children ages 3-6 and 7-12.
